Why?

35 million adolescents in Uganda and Zambia are missing out on a secondary education.

While primary education is almost universal across Africa, only 1 in 3 can attend secondary education.

Not enough secondary schools exist and where they do, many students experience a poor standard of education and an unsafe environment.

Every child deserves a high-quality education no matter their gender, background or circumstance. Evidence shows that PEAS school enrol more girls than average, students from poorer backgrounds and with lower prior learning than other school types.

PEAS builds and runs secondary schools in rural, and underserved communities across sub-Saharan Africa. With 36 schools educating 20,000 students annually and reaching an additional 200,000 children through government partnerships in Uganda, Zambia, and Ghana, our goal is clear: **leave no child behind.**

You can support a school like Forest High School


Forest Secondary School is located in a rural part of Uganda. Most of the community here work as subsistence farmers and the village can only be reached on rough dirt roads. Many of the 300 children here have a long walk to school, **but they come every day because this is their chance to change their futures.**

Salome is a student at Forest. She says: "I have been coming to the school since the beginning of 2020. I love the way the teachers teach here. In this community, there were no secondary schools. Now we have one and the kids don't need to walk so far anymore. I love living in the dorm as we have a lot of time to study, and there are no disturbances there. We get food as well at the boarding school. I play football and netball at school, I like sports. I also participate in the school's vegetable garden. My dream for the future is to become an accountant and a peacemaker"
